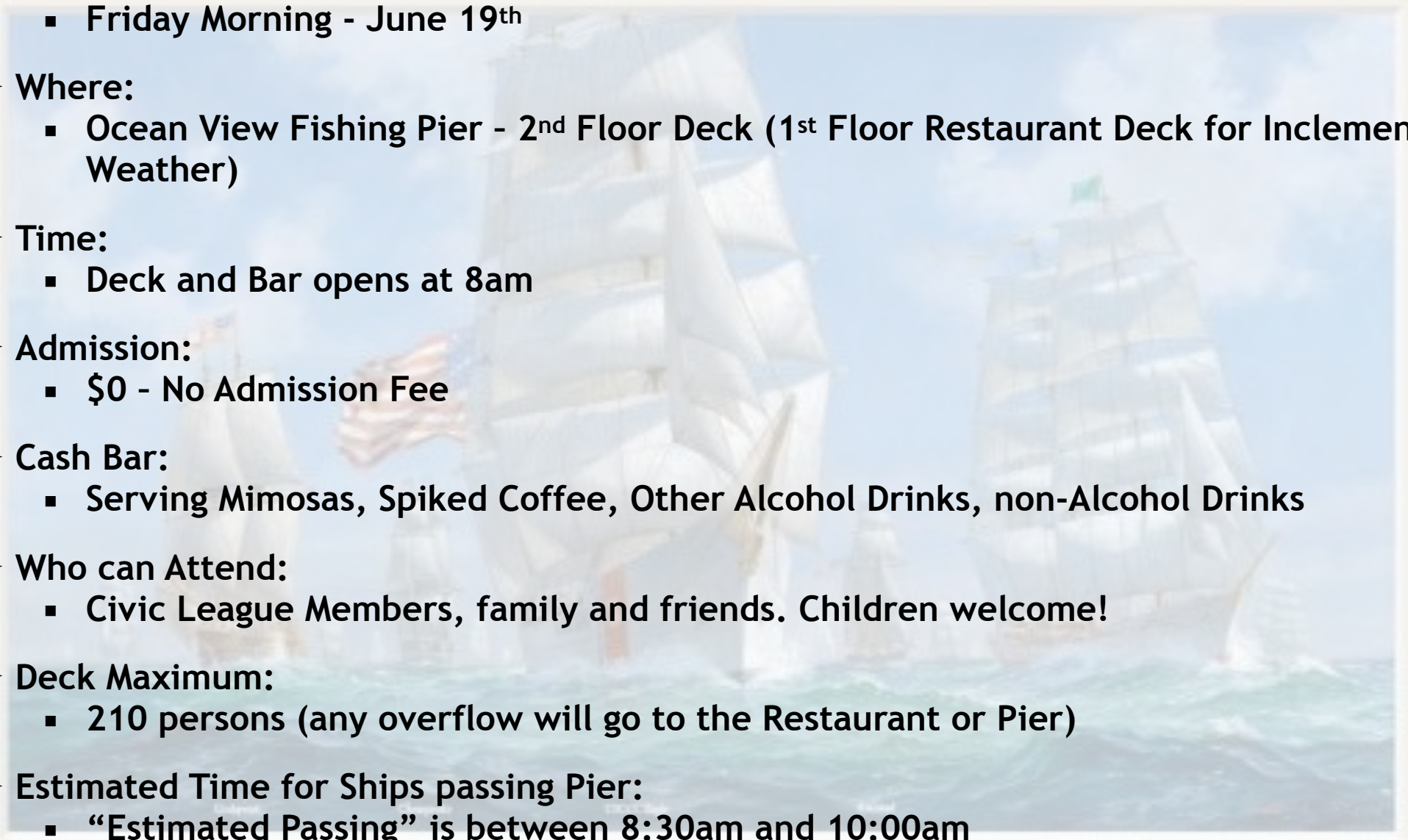


- **Monthly Crime Statistics: NPD CRO: Officer Jhet Sarmiento**

- **At Home:**
  - ❖ Close the blinds, shades and curtains at night
  - ❖ Lock the door immediately after you enter the house
  - ❖ Keep your Garage Door Closed and Locked
  - ❖ Lock your car
- **NEVER** - leave valuables or guns in your car even if the car is locked.
- **ALWAYS** - keep your car doors locked when remotely warming up your car
- **Heads Up** - We have requested **(once again)** increased Radar Monitoring on EOVA so watch your speed and perform proper signaling

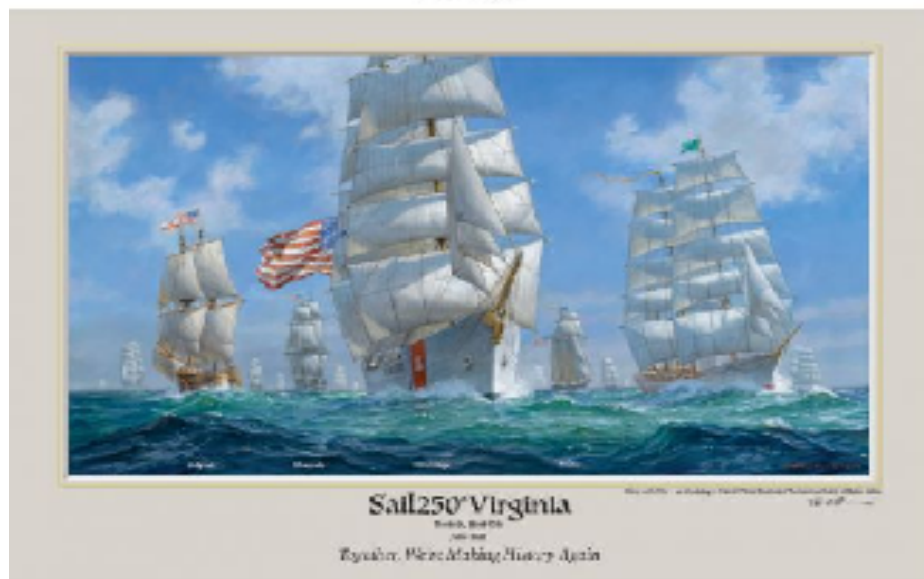
